New rules may allow Australian police to detain "conspiracy theorists"

The Australian state is rolling out increasingly fascistic laws, when will people finally say enough is enough?

ew rules passing in the Australian state of Victoria could see "conspiracy theorists" and those "suspected by health authorities of being likely to spread the virus" detained in quarantine centres, according to **The Age**

The rules are amendments being added to the Omnibus (Emergency Measures) Bill, which was **first passed back in April**.

The proposed detention would last "for the period reasonably necessary to eliminate or reduce a serious risk to public health".

To translate that from bureaucrat into English: it means as for long as they want, or can get away with.

Legislation with this kind of vague verbiage is always a red flag, but then Victoria is currently over-flowing with warning signs of this kind.

VICTORIA – THE WORLD'S FASCIST TEST RUN?

Maybe you haven't been following exactly how bad things are getting in Australia – and most especially Victoria – but they have essentially aggressively seized their opportunity to create a fascist micro-state. A social Petri dish, in which to culture some tyranny.

They have declared both a "state of emergency" AND a "state of

disaster" for a disease which has killed fewer than a thousand people in 9 months across the entire country.

For a sense of perspective, in 2018 **over three times as many people died of influenza**, and the same number again committed suicide.

As of right now Australia has just 16 cases of coronavirus **classified as** "severe".

And yet, among other highly authoritarian regulations in place, Victoria currently has:

- A curfew, everybody must be home by 9pm and remain there until 5am.
- Special work permits for "essential workers", which must be carried at all times and presented to any law enforcement officer that asks.
- Police check points on the roads "leaving a restricted area" is now a criminal offense.
- "Indefinitely suspended" all Jury trials all criminal proceedings are now bench trials (they tried that in Scotland, too)
- A 60 minute limit for anyone leaving their home to exercise, and a rule forbidding people from going more than 5km (3.1 miles) from their home.
- Instituted a mandatory masks for anyone leaving the house for any reason.

Though notionally intended to be "temporary measures" which only lasted six weeks, they have already extended that timeline for a further six months. There is some planned "loosening" of these restrictions, but with such vague and mutable conditions it's unlikely this "new normal" is going away.

Indeed the "emergency" is so comparatively minor that this precedent means almost any future event can be designated a "disaster" or "emergency", and used as excuse to impose authoritarian social controls.

THE EVER QUOTABLE DANIEL ANDREWS

The Victorian Premier, **Daniel Andrews** has been a quote machine during this pandemic. When challenged on the draconian nature of the new rules Andrews said [our emphasis]:

The most logical, the most prudent thing to do, is to simply accept the fact that we have a need for rules ... they're not about individual liberty, they're about public health."

When asked about the 74 protesters arrested in Melbourne this past weekend, he said [again..our emphasis]:

It's not smart, it's not right...it's not the time for protest... No one has the right to make choices like that, that potentially puts at risk everything we are working towards."

Andrews is currently subject to a **vote of no confidence from the opposition**.

ENTHUSIASTIC POLICE BRUTALITY

The Victorian police have certainly launched into their new mandates with gusto. Raiding the homes of people who share certain facebook posts before arresting them for "incitement" and violently detaining those who weren't wearing masks in public.

Oh, they are also detaining people at **checkpoints for no reason** at all, and **hitting protesters with their cars** putting them in hospital. Some people are being arrested for **refusing to identify themselves** or **"driving on a highway"** or **"refusing to follow orders"**.

The situation in Victoria is terrible, but it's not much worse than here in the UK, or the US or many other countries around the world. People need to resist it, non compliance and non-conformity have never been more important.

We're in a grip of a fascism pilot scheme, and the only way to stop it is to see it and say it.







This is the Military Industrial Complex that President Dwight Eisenhower warned about. Like his contemporary Aldous Huxley, Eisenhower was very much a part of that complex, along with the intelligence agencies that they both helped promote.

The effective suspension of the legislature, **habeas corpus** and even legal rights such as **trial by jury**, the use of martial law and curfew, the commandeering of the press and media — all this points to the military nature of those behind the seizure of power.

Likewise the replacement of civilian policing with military policing is a wartime measure in the absence of what we think of as war (but it is a possible precursor to war; conventional or hybrid; and it may be war on the population as enemy).

If military law replaces legislative and judicial law, as it has, then the military is in the driving seat. I don't see any argument.

Under no definition, medical or linguistic, can you quarantine the whole population. Quarantine is the sheltering and quartering of the sick. What we are seeing is not quarantine, it's house imprisonment and, if you break it, the explicit threat of internment.

It ain't quarantine however much they use the word.

The threat of indefinite detention (as per Ardern) is internment.

The test at the heart of these measures is not scientific thus it is arbitrary.

You may even be detained on suspicion of being infected — arrest on suspicion.

None of these measures requires a warrant nor does it appear to be subject to judicial review.

These are precisely the military measures that proved so controversial at the height of the Irish Troubles.

Will we have our Bloody Sunday too?

What do we do if someone refuses to be tested, well they can't. If someone in one of our facilities refuses to get tested, they have to keep staying. You either get your test done and make sure you are cleared or we will keep you in a facility longer

Eisenhower was the one who changed the role of the CIA from intelligence to covert military operations. He spoke his warning about the MIC with forked tongue. Sixty years later, he would be very satisfied with the outcome.







NZ also is in dire straits. When you think of what is happening, your head begins to spin.

It all happened so suddenly: we all got locked up in our respective countries, borders closed before we knew what was happening. Even those of us who knew things were getting worse over the decades, especially the last years, we never expected anything to this extent in our lives. We never expected anything like this ever really.

I remember the panic I felt when locked up in solitary confinement like the worst criminals with the prisoner's allocated 1 hr walk within a narrow perimeter: images of Nazi Germany rather than fascist Italy kept coming up. It seemed even worse, at least then you could move around, you could meet, you were never cut off from other humans. In fact I felt that prisoners were usually better off than us as they could do activities together, they could have meals together. Certainly we were not being shot at, not being physically tortured, at least not in the spring. But the psychological torture and the ban from going out (France had like Australia all these measures, except last spring they didn't yet have the coercive means they've now got) have equal deleterious effects. Just because these effects are less immediately visible, it doesn't make them less serious. In fact in the longer term, they can prove worse, because they are slowly destructive. Physical repression kills you rapidly and because its visible it can bring about opposition more rapidly too.

Anyhow we all missed the opportunity of putting an end to it last spring: if then people had massively descended on the streets, or even the 1000s or hundreds of 1000s who since then have had then immediately protested, we would not be where we are today: then they did not have the police force to beat us up. Its like with Hitler in January of 1933 when he became chancellor he did not have the coercive force needed, it took nearly 18 months to develop that. In the interim months, they did get

rid of the active opposition: the camps were for the Left initially, the idea of using them for a genocide of Jews and others came later.

Still, Nazism could be implemented because before coercion was possible people either passively accepted the new norms, implemented them on each other, and even took actions that went beyond the rules. This your everyday person did. That is each of us individuals have a role in what happens. The very vast majority began to impose structural and behavioural changes within their spheres without being forced to do so. People in large numbers began to denounce one other. Some out of fear: fear is a terrible weapon. Others out of self-interest, out of conformism, the fear of what your neighbour will say, out of the desire for status since status is largely defined by having authorities say how good you are, thus out of the ambition of external success, the fear of losing their jobs and livelihoods, a large number because for them the law is the law, whatever the law says, and they dont realise that a coup d'etat need not have tanks on the streets like in Spain in 1936, but a coup d'etat consists of a change of legislation permitting repression.

Is this not what is now happening again? Like then, headmasters and teachers are doing precisely that in their schools.

And even many among the few who understand are remaining quiet: what can I do? If I speak out, even to my colleagues, I may lose my job, and who knows may be denounced, arrested, and what good will it do?

We should be first very honest with ourselves if we now wish a return to human life. Its human to fear doing something in times like this, its human to fear speaking out. Also among those of us who are speaking out, our motivations for speaking out may be not all that pure. That is something I have very much experienced in the last few years: I have found among the mainstream, notably the mainstream elites, a greater honesty: as long as you think like them, as long as you are loyal to the official doctrine, believe me talent is rewarded, loyalty is rewarded, you find help and support all along the road. In one word, they are united. I had thought that those who have been fighting to maintain human values, who have been at the forefront of many battles" in my lifetime, would be united by these values, all the more so because we are so few, that there would be mutual help, mutual support. Well I can tell you I was greatly disappointed. There was none of the camaraderie I had thought there would be, on the contrary no one helped one other: it was rather a competition to establish oneself as an adulated critic with a following.

All this to say: we too should be honest with ourselves and do some soul searching. We are each one of us responsible for not having been able to stop this utter dystopia

happening. If we can be honest first with ourselves, then possibly we can rise to the occasion, and at last unite and successfully bring back the freedoms we have lost, at last bring back the possibility to merely live. Time is against us: the longer we allow this to unroll, the harder it will become and the higher the number of victims. Sure Nazi Germany is no more, and humanity survived, but millions of lives were destroyed. This time too humanity will ultimately survive, but there will be uncountable numbers of victims the longer it lasts. Is this what we want?
